December 20, 2021

It goes without saying that the past 2 years have been a challenging for everybody and ICAM was no exception. When the Covid-19 pandemic arrived in early Spring of 2020 our entire operation and mission changed. All of our usual outreach programs were shut down and the priority became the safety of our employees and to do whatever we could to help with keeping the town informed and updated. Currently, the staff and volunteers are still diligently protecting themselves and others by expecting unvaccinated people to wear a mask in the ICAM facilities and providing plenty of hand sanitizer and cleaning wipes, and keeping group gatherings to a maximum of 5 people. Moving forward, we are hoping to be able to restart our youth programs by Summer of 2022.

2021 HIGHLIGHTS

- Town Meetings - The Town hired Port Broadcasting to stream the two outdoor meetings live, as well as set-up audio and a projector to display the warrants on the wall of the tent. ICAM provided the camera to connect to their system so that we could video switch between the camera and the warrants for viewers at home. Port Broadcasting also provided the audio. We went live through ICAM's YouTube Channel as well as on the ICAM Government and streaming Channels.

- ICAM has been following the CDC and town guidelines in regards to availability and being open to the public. In the beginning of the year it was by appointment only and social distancing could be maintained. As people have been able to get vaccinated, masks are only required if an individual is unvaccinated. Some volunteers have returned to recording their programs; and we have added a number of new programs.

- Besides the local committee meetings on the ICAM Government Channel we are also showing meetings from beacon hill, which include Joint Committee Public Hearings, Special Commission Meetings and Gov Baker Covid-19 Updates.
 - ICAM is a member of the Greater Cape Ann Chamber of Commerce (GCACC). Beth Meyer is working with a couple of GCACC staff and developing a new monthly program called North Shore Highlights, highlighting local businesses and organizations.
 - We have awarded scholarships every year to deserving Ipswich students who are pursuing careers in communications or related fields, several of whom have gone on to related careers. This past spring we awarded a scholarship to Wesley Smith who is attending Gordon College, majoring in Communications.
 - Virtually all of our programming and archives are available through both cable and webcasting. Anyone can view our programming at any time through our website, the town website, YouTube or Facebook.
 - Many of our locally produced shows are being shown in other communities. We are members of Mass Access, an organization for Massachusetts Community Access Centers that facilitates sharing programs between communities.

ORGANIZATION

Our Executive Director, Elizabeth Meyer, continues to lead ICAM in an exemplary manor. She has proven to be a very capable manager of a complex operation that requires both technical and interpersonal skills. In addition, she plans and manages all of our programs, including video workshops for ages 8-80 and summer clubs for fourth through eighth graders (obviously in non-pandemic times). She, along our Production Coordinator Alexandra Derderian, one part-time employee and three videographers represent the paid staff. However, we could not produce this many shows without the help of our two dozen plus amazing volunteers who help us cover various events around town and produce their own programs.

GOING FORWARD

- ICAM is constantly trying to stay abreast with new technology. We are utilizing the Hybrid System the town installed in Meeting Room A. All of our programming on all 3 channels are also available on the web. Viewers can watch it either live or on-demand.
- To help keep up with the everchanging technology, we are members of Mass Access, the nonprofit organization for community access stations in Massachusetts as well as the national organization Alliance for Community Media. These 2 organizations support local community access stations like ICAM by providing network opportunity, new technology (equipment) demonstrations and programs sharing amongst its members. These organizations are also key to lobbying for legislation to makes changes to better support the new technology as viewers become more apt to only using internet instead of cable TV.
- We hope to get back to training volunteers and youth programs. The programs will resume once it is deemed safe for group gatherings.
- We are looking into to more live broadcasts, possibly even live sports events; and a call-in show is still a possibility.
- We continue to expand and generate new and interesting programming, as shown by the attached sample.

- Many of our locally produced shows are being shown in other communities. We are members of Mass Access, an organization for Massachusetts Community Access Centers that facilitates sharing programs between communities.
- We have broadcast over 1000 programs over the 3 channels in the last 12 months which consists of locally produced programs as well as programs produced by other access centers.
- We continue to produce 100s of new, original programs, including over 150 local government meetings, 250 public programs and 125 school events (many of those being sporting events recorded by volunteer students and parents).
- We have established a good presence on social media, including Facebook, YouTube, Twitter and Instagram.

FINANCIALS

ICAM continues to operate on very solid footing financially. It is important to note that no tax money is used, as we are 100% funded by Comcast and Verizon. We are striving to plan for financial security for the foreseeable future and keep up with the changing state of technology. We have filed all necessary tax forms and submitted required reports to the state attorney general to maintain our non-profit status. We have also instituted a formal budgeting process.

BACKGROUND:

Prior to the expiration of the license for Comcast to provide cable television services to the town of Ipswich in 2006, the Ipswich Cable Advisory Board (CAB) set out to negotiate terms with Comcast for a renewal license and also to bring in Verizon for an initial license so that we would have two competing cable providers in Ipswich. The negotiations were successful and the Board of Selectmen signed 10-year licenses with Verizon in July of 2006 and Comcast in July of 2007. One of the key provisions of these licenses is the requirement by the FCC to provide local access programming for Public, Educational and Government purposes (often referred to as PEG). This programming can be provided by the cable companies themselves, as was done for many years by Comcast via a studio in Newburyport shared with four other towns. Or, as was the case here with both Verizon and Comcast, the cable service providers can opt to fund an independently operated studio for each town. The funding agreed to was 4% of gross revenues.

The CAB later came to an agreement with the Board of Selectman that the most efficient way to set up and operate a studio and manage the funding was to create an independent non-profit corporation as is done in most other communities. Therefore, Ipswich Community Access Media (ICAM) was incorporated on September 8, 2008 and a formal letter of agreement defining the relationship with the town was signed on March 31, 2009.

The Board of Directors was appointed per the bylaws of ICAM and an Executive Director was hired in July of 2009 to set up and run the studio. That studio in the basement of town hall became fully functional on May 4, 2010 when we recorded the "Candidates Forum" question and answer show for the upcoming election.

We have been in our High Street location for several years now and it has proved to be an excellent facility with good working space for staff and room for volunteer and student activities and workshops. And being directly across the street from the High School/Middle School it's ideal for coordinating our student activities.

The town signed very favorable contracts with our two providers in 2017, The Verizon contract expires January 3, 2024 and Comcast expires August 20, 2027, so our finances should be stable at least through 2025. This is very significant given the rapidly changing state of technology and the manner in which people now consume content.

Summary:

ICAM has now been in business for 11 years. We have accomplished a lot in that time and will strive to continue to improve and stay current especially with regard to the rapid changes going on in the industry. We feel that we have one of the best access stations around compared to other communities of similar size. We are fortunate to have a talented and involved Board in place and a dedicated staff. We are financially secure and are planning for the future. It is inspiring to watch as folks who are accountants, teachers, engineers, etc. by day showing up for a studio shoot and running the cameras and controls in their spare time. We thank the Select Board for their continued support and look forward to continuing to serve the town of Ipswich.
